The Department provides triploid eggs and fish food to each school. Trout Unlimited provides all the necessary aquaria equipment to maintain the fish alive. This is an excellent program that allows the Department to reach thousands of students and their families across Arizona. Students learn about the Departments' mission, water conservation, ecosystems, fish culture and sport fishing in the state.
